

# Making Green Screen Magic!



## Let's Get Started!

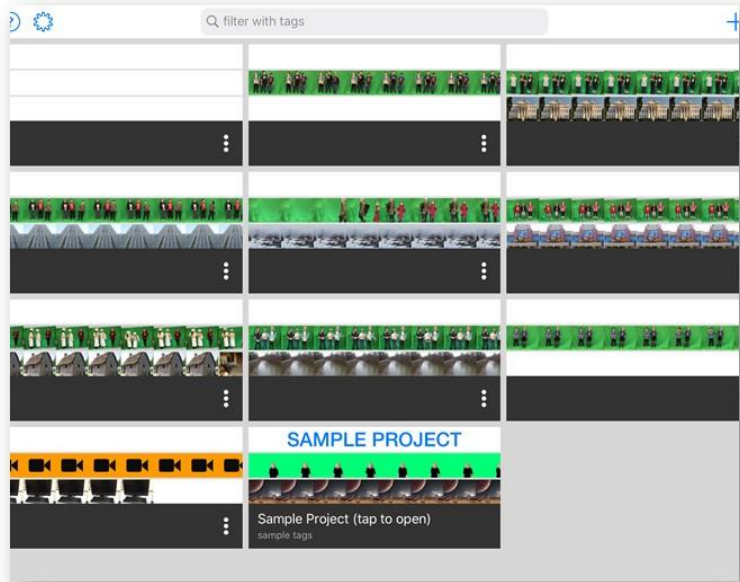
1. Locate your background image:
  - Browse images available in the iPad's Photos folder. If you do not see one that will suit your project, open the Safari app on the iPad and search & download an online image to the iPad's Photos folder.
2. Using the iPad's built-in camera, record your video/take picture in front of the green screen.

3. Open the Do Ink app.



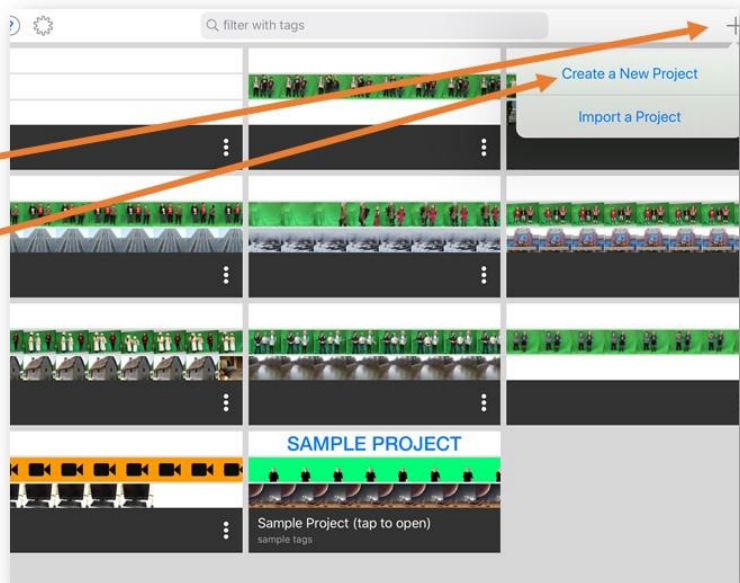
**The Do Ink Gallery** —→

This is the first screen you will see when you open the Do Ink app. Here, you will see all of your saved projects!



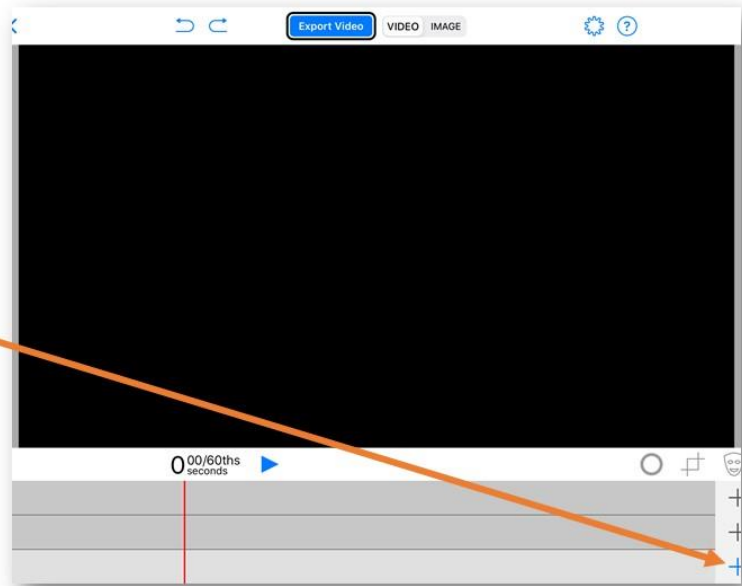
**Start a New Project**

1. Click the "+" sign on the top right, then click **Create a New Project**.



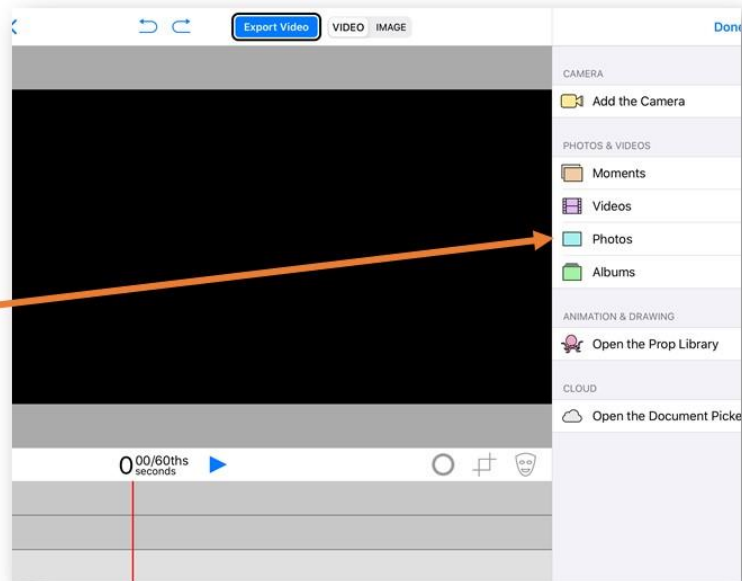
Import your background image/video to the bottom layer of the timeline  
(can be more than one image and/or video)

2. Click the “+” on the timeline’s bottom layer.



Import your background image/video (cont.)

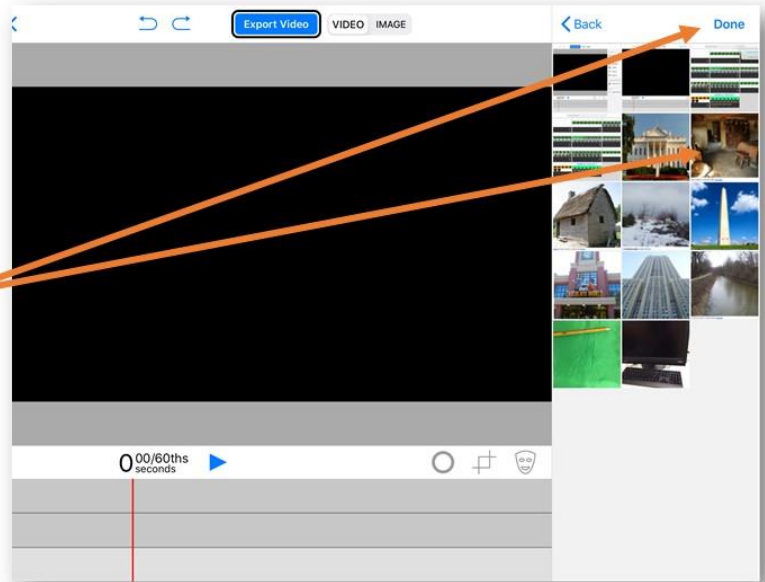
3. In the right pane, tap **Photos** or **Videos**, depending on the format of your background file.



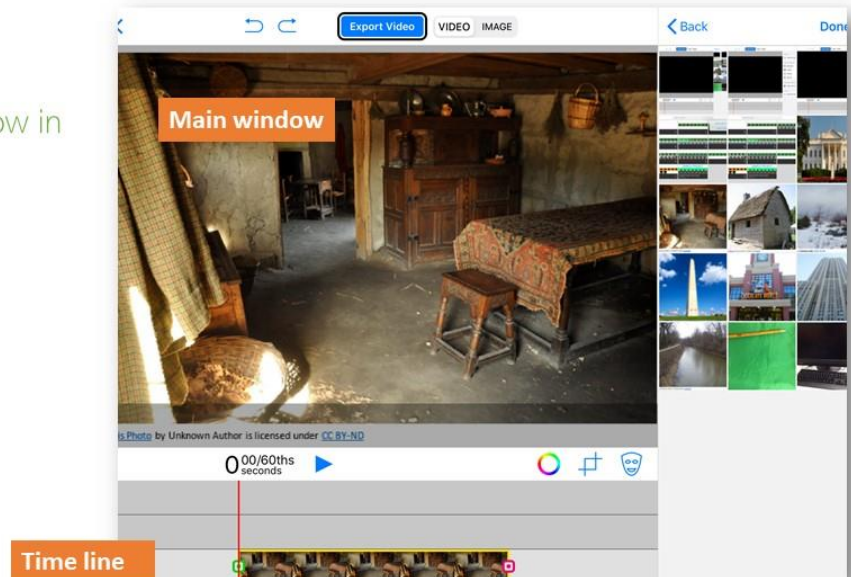
Import your background image/video (cont.)

4. Tap the desired image/video for your background.

5. Tap **Done**.



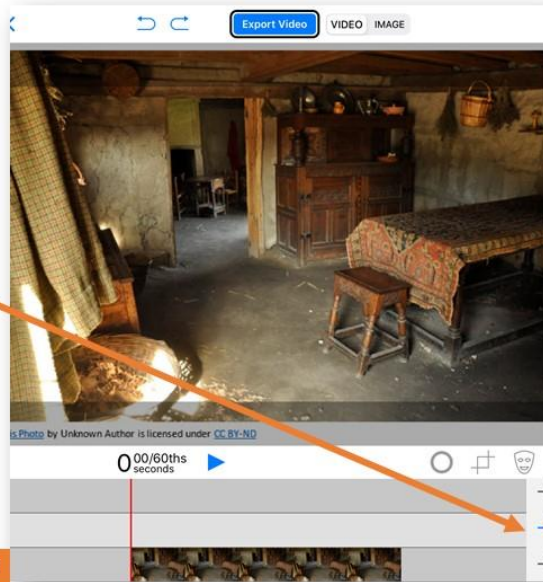
Voila! Your background is now in place.



Now, let's import the image/video you recorded using the green screen to the layer above your background.

6. Tap the '+' sign on the layer above your background.

Bottom layer = background



Import your green screen image/video (cont.)

7. In the right pane, tap the green screen image/video you would like to use.

8. Tap Done.

Upper layer = foreground

Bottom layer = background



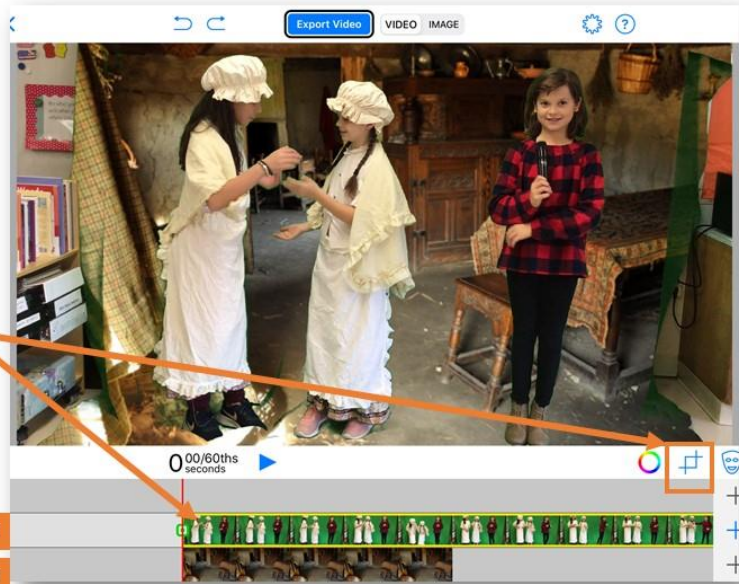
Nice! Now, edit the background and foreground images/videos as necessary...

**To crop foreground or background object:**

Tap the object on the timeline you would like to edit, then tap the crop tool.

*Notice the additional editing tools that appear below the timeline when you tap the foreground or background objects (not shown here).*

Upper layer = foreground  
Bottom layer = background



To crop foreground or background object (cont.)

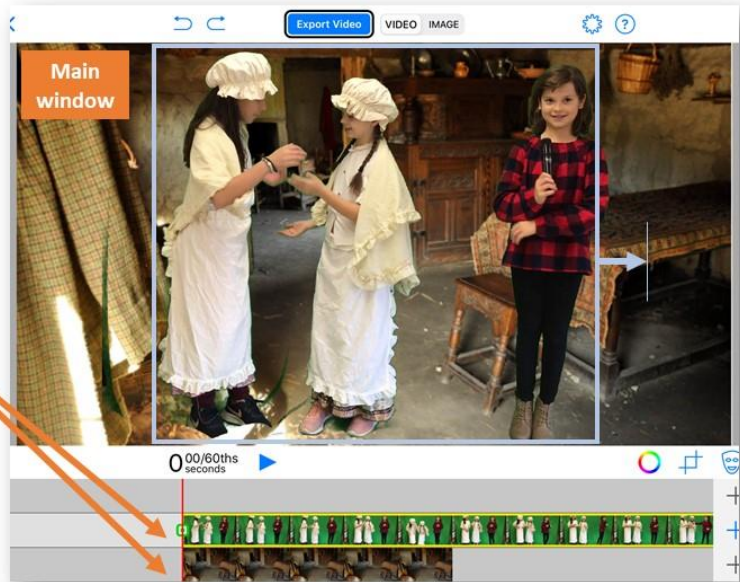
Drag the corner bracket(s) to select the area you would like to include in your project.



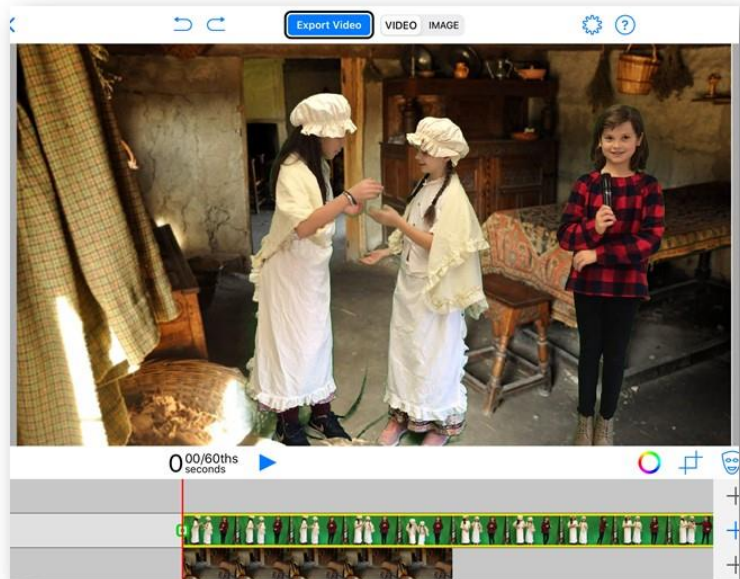
To adjust the position of the foreground or background...

On the timeline, tap the object you would like to edit.

In the main window, drag the object to the desired position and/or pinch to resize.



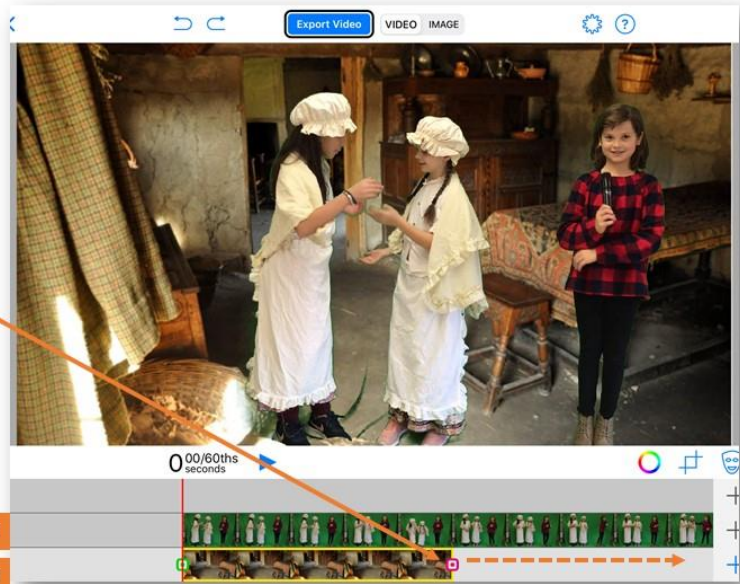
Nice!



Now, check that the background object on the bottom layer is as long as the foreground object above it.

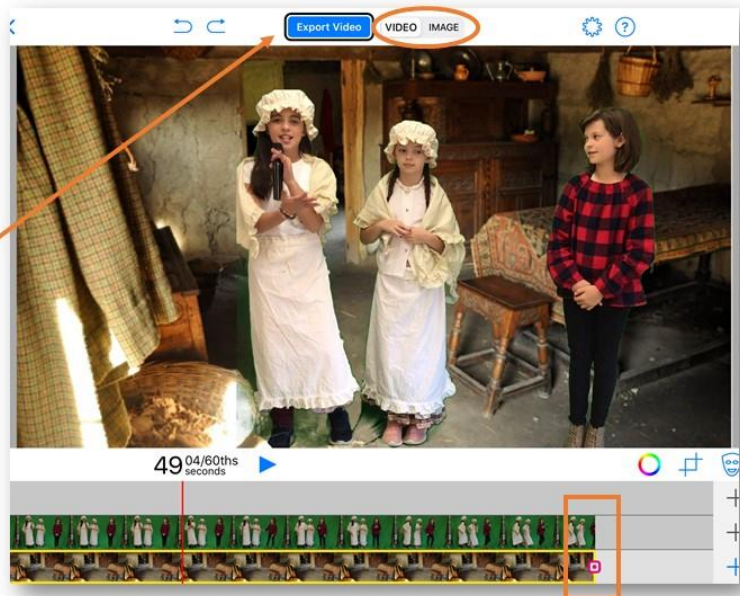
9. To extend the background image, tap the object on the timeline, then press and drag the red arrow that appears at the end of the object to extend the object to match the length of the object above.

Upper layer = foreground  
Bottom layer = background



Finalize and export project to iPad's Photos folder.

10. After final edits have been made, tap the appropriate format button above the main window (Video/Image), then the **Export Video** or the **Capture Image** button (depending on format selected) above the main window.





Finalize and export project to iPad's Photos folder (cont.)

**11.** Save project to iPad's Photos folder.

**Video format:** Tap **Save to the Camera Roll**.

**Image format:** Tap the export icon below the image, then **Save Image**.
